#### Prayer Focus Update Friday 21st May

The situation in India continues to worsen, it is estimated 2,000 Christian ministers have died from Covid – the figure is much higher as this is just the main RC and Anglican Communion churches. The suicide of Drs and nurses continues to rise as does the covid death figures. The national government continue to refuse aid and help (including oxygen and ventilators) from Christian organisations (NGOs & charities). The West coast of India has now also been hit by cyclone Tauktae.

Pastor Blesson in Kolkata (Calcutta) has started an online prayer group for pastors – at 4.00am each morning. It was supposed to be an hour, but they have run on until 08.00. It is open to all India pastors. Pray the Lord will use this group to fill then with his Holy Spirit and comfort and strengthen them. Pray for Blesson to have the energy and wisdom to maintain this daily commitment and pray protection over him, Jaya is Dr wife and his family. Continue to pray for M who is fighting covid.
