### Vacancies – Voluntary

**PCC Member** - The PCC meets 6 times per year currently on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of alternate months, January, March... etc at 7.30pm for 2 hours. Usual Term of service is 3 years for a maximum of 2 terms.

The PCC is the main decision maker for the Church and has a responsibility to promote the mission of God in it's Parish. The PCC is the financial approving and budget setting body, as guided by our Treasurer. To ensure all areas of Church life are covered, PCC members are "Champions" for these different area & report regularly to the PCC (please see minutes of past meetings). Champions are appointed in collaboration and after conversation with Jeremy.

For example. Anna Finey is the Champion for Children and Youth, this does not mean she is the lead in these areas but reports to the PCC about developments, prayer requests, areas for the PCC to discuss and make a decision on if necessary. We have template reporting forms.

The areas that will need new champions are: Prayer: Contemporary Worship: Traditional Worship. If you are passionate about any of these areas, please pray and ask God if it is the time for you to serve on the PCC.

**Church Warden** - The role of the churchwarden is extremely varied but generally involves management, maintenance and mission. Church wardens are the foremost in representing the laity and in co-operating with the Vicar, they have a duty to maintain order and decency in the church and churchyard. In cooperation with the incumbent, churchwardens are generally responsible for the day-to-day functioning of the parish.
